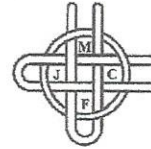

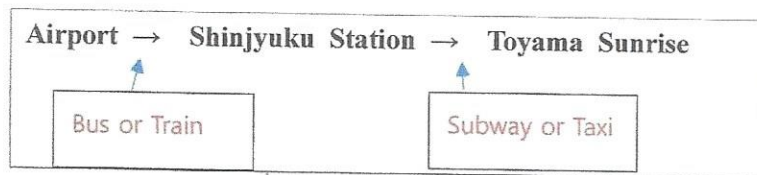
### (4) Transportation Fee:

① From Narita Airport to Shinjuku Station

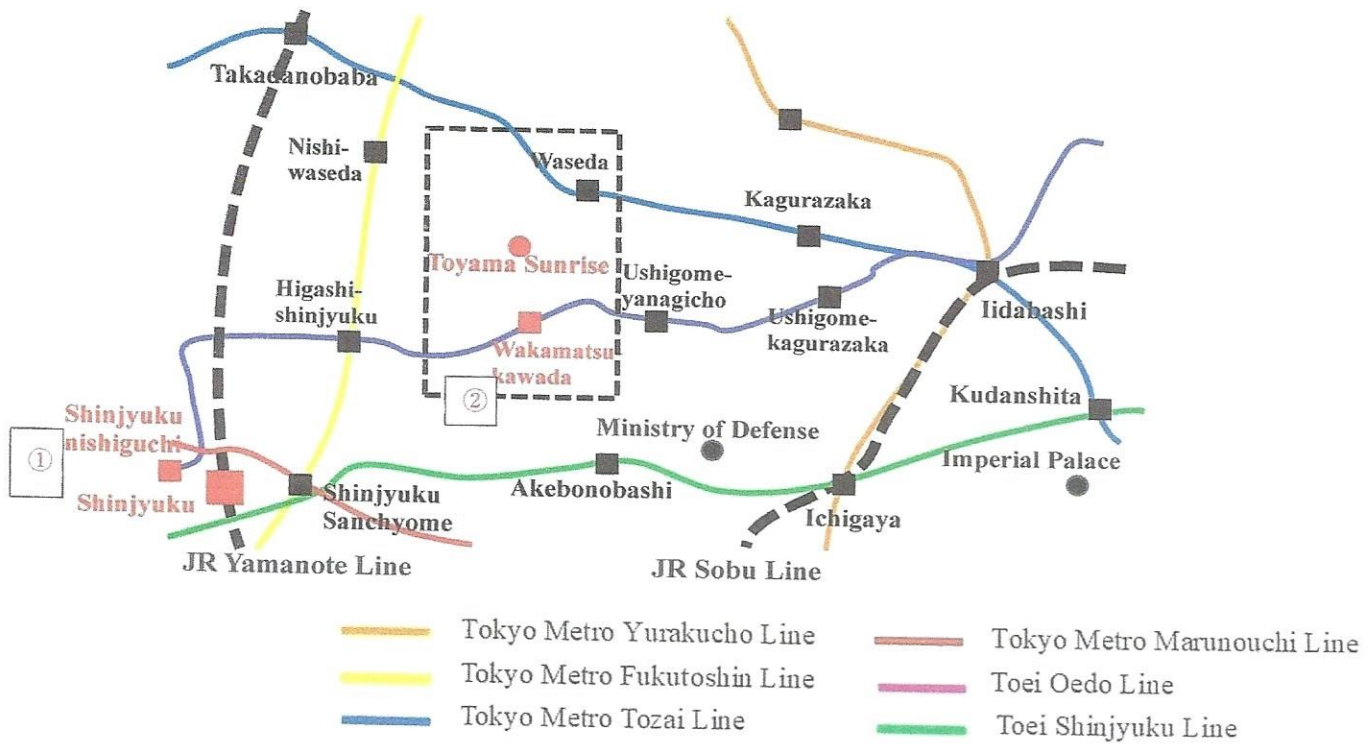

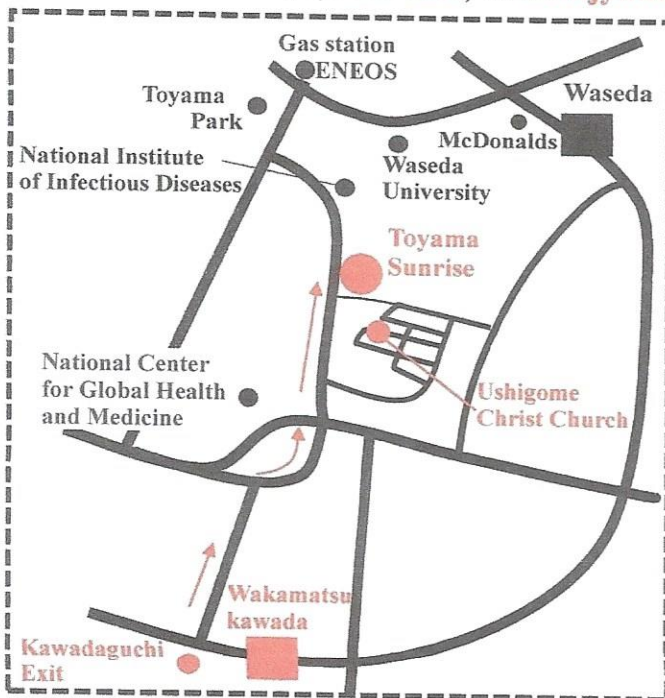


③ Take Subway from Shinjuku Station to Toyama Sunrise (about 30 minutes)

### 1. Take Subway (Oedo-line) at Shinjyuku Nishiguchi Station



2. Get-off at Wakamatsu-Kawada Station.

3. Go out **Kawadaguchi-Exit**

4. Walk 10 minutes to Toyama Sunrise from Wakamatsu-Kawada Station

5. Or, Take Taxi from Shinjyuku Station to Toyama Sunrise (about 10 minutes 1300Yen)
